

An Ordinance of Franklin Township establishing an intergovernmental agreement between and among this municipality and the Named Municipalities, the County of Erie, and signatories of the Agreement and Bylaws of the Erie County Solid Waste Management Council as incorporated herein.

WHEREAS, this Franklin Township desires to collectively associate itself together with the municipalities named herein; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined desirable for the purposes of this municipality to jointly provide solid waste management services.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by this Franklin Township in accordance with the Intergovernmental Cooperation Law, Act of July 12, 1972, P.L. 762, No. 180 as follows:

Section 1 - This Franklin Township elects to become a party to an agreement with the above named municipalites and signatories.

Section 2 - The conditions of the agreements, the manner and intent of financing the agreement, the duration of the term of the agreement, the organizational structure necessary to implement the agreement, and the manner in which property, real or personal shall be acquired, managed or disposed of are as specified within the Agreement and Bylaws of the Erie County Solid Waste Management Council which was presented before the Board of Supervisors of this Franklin Township at a public meeting of August 14, 1985 and which is set forth in the Agreement and Bylaws of the Erie County Solid Waste Management Council and incorporated herein as Appendix A.

Section 3 - The Delegate is hereby authorized and directed to take whatever steps are necessary, sign whatever documents are necessary, and do all things necessary to become a party to the Agreement and Bylaws of the Erie County Solid Waste Management Council.

Section 4 - This ordinance shall become effective on September 21, 1985.
