

FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP

ORDINANCE 1-96

An ordinance providing for the prohibition of parking on various streets and roads within Franklin Township.

WHEREAS, the Supervisors of Franklin Township deem it necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens to restrict parking within the limits of the Township.

BEING ENACTED, by the Supervisors of Franklin Township, Erie County, Pennsylvania as follows:

SECTION ONE:

Parking prohibited at all times in certain locations. Parking shall be prohibited at all times in the following locations:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Side of the road</u>	<u>Between</u>
New Road	Both sides	The intersection of New Road and Route 98 to 1,584 feet east of the intersection on New Road
Route 98	Both sides	The intersection of New Road and Route 98 both north and south of the intersection 1,584 feet on Route 98
Route 98	Both sides	The intersection of Old State Road and Route 98 both north and south of the intersection 1,584 feet on Route 98
Old State Road	Both sides	The intersection of Route 98 and Old State Road both east and west of the intersection 1,584 feet on Old State Road

SECTION TWO:

Signs. Signs designating the no parking zone shall be conspicuously posted at the beginning and end of the no parking zone as it is defined above.

SECTION THREE:

Penalty. Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance is guilty of a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$35.00, plus costs.

SECTION FOUR:

The within Ordinance is enacted by the Township pursuant to the powers set forth in the Second Class Township Code (53 P.S. §65724) and the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code (75 P.S. §6109 and §3353).

This Ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after its approval and after advertising as is required by law.

The enactment of this ordinance hereby repeals the previous Parking Ordinance #1-93.


