SPEED LIMITS AND TRAFFIC CONTROL

ORDINANCE NO. 2 of 2000

An Ordinance establishing speed limits and traffic control for motor vehicles on certain roadways within Franklin Township, Erie County, Pennsylvania.

WHEREAS, certain streets or roads exist within Franklin Township where no speed limits have been established or a change in conditions has occurred to warrant a reevaluation of the speed limits previously adopted; and

WHEREAS, certain streets or roads exist within Franklin Township where no traffic control has been established or a change in conditions has occurred to warrant a reevaluation of traffic control previously adopted; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin Township Board of Supervisors, in order to advance the welfare and safety of the residents of the Township and such other persons who use said streets and roads, deems it necessary to enact the speed limitations and traffic control on certain streets and roads in Franklin Township; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, after completing engineering and traffic studies of the following streets and roads, find the following speed limits and traffic control to be warranted in accordance with the Vehicle Code of Pennsylvania.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, and it is enacted and ordained, by the Board of Supervisors of Franklin Township, as follows:

Section 1. The maximum speed limit for the following streets and roads is hereby established as follows:

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be enforced in accordance with the provisions of the Vehicle Code of Pennsylvania as it pertains to fines and other penalties.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall supercede and repeal any speed limit or traffic control previously established on the street or road in the location specified.

Section 5. Should any provision of this ordinance be found unconstitutional or otherwise illegal or in any other manner unenforceable, the remaining sections of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
