REPEAL OF ELECTION TO ADMINISTER AND ENFORCE STATE UNIFORM CONSTRUCTION CODE

ORDINANCE NO. 2 OF 2012

AN ORDINANCE TO PROMOTE THE GENERAL HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE OF THE CITIZENS OF FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP AND TO CONFORM TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE PENNSYLVANIA CONSTRUCTION CODE ACT AND REGULATIONS TO THE ACT PROMULGATED BY THE PENNSYLVANIA DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND INDUSTRY.

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Construction Code Act (the "Code") requires the enactment of an appropriate ordinance by municipalities electing to administer and enforce the building code provisions of the Code;

WHEREAS, the Franklin Township Board of Supervisors on March 17, 2004 enacted Ordinance #2 of 2004 electing to administer and enforce the provisions of the Pennsylvania Construction Code Act, Act 45 of 1999, 35 P.S. §§7210.101-7210.1103; and

WHEREAS, a majority of the Franklin Township Board of Supervisors no longer wish to administer and enforce the Code and desire that developers, contractors and citizens of Franklin Township conduct business directly with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Labor and Industry to determine the requirements of the applicability of the Code to construction projects; and/or to secure a building permit; and/or to appeal decisions of inspectors; and/or to respond to enforcement actions.

NOW, **THEREFORE**, it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

Ordinance No. 2 of 2004 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

This Ordinance shall become effective December 1, 2012.
