ACCEPTANCE OF WESTERN TRAIL DRIVE

Ordinance #3 of 2002

An ordinance adopting and annexing Western Trail Drive, a public right-of-way, privately maintained road, as a Township Road.

WHEREAS, Franklin Township, a second class township in Erie County, Pennsylvania, desires to exercise its authority under the Second Class Township Code to adopt and annex Western Trail Drive, a public right-of-way, privately maintained road;

WHEREAS, the developer of Western Trail Subdivision by agreement with the Township and through the previous dedication of Western Trail Drive as a public right-of-way; desires that the privately maintained road become a Township maintained road;

WHEREAS, the extents of Western Trail Drive have been described in the Township approved Western Trails Subdivision 2 plan and recorded in the Erie County Recorder of Deeds Office the 10th day of June, 1993;

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the public, the Township and the residents of the Western Trails Subdivision that the Township adopt and annex the road; and

WHEREAS, after due and timely notice by publication, as required by law; and having held a public hearing on the proposed ordinance

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors does hereby enact and ordain:

That Western Trail Drive is hereby adopted and annexed as a Franklin Township road upon the filing of a certified and attested copy of this ordinance and the attached copy of the Western Trails Subdivision 2 Plan with the Erie County Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately.
